SUMMARY—Authorizes Board of Wildlife Commissioners to
establish area where hunting of certain mule deer is
prohibited. (BDR 45-865)

AN ACT relating to wildlife; authorizing the Board of Wildlife
Commissioners to establish an area where the hunting of
certain mule deer is prohibited; and providing other
matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law requires the Board of Wildlife Commissioners to establish policies
2 and adopt regulations for the preservation, protection, management and restoration
3 of wildlife and wildlife habitats. (NRS 501.105)

4 This bill authorizes the Board to establish a management area for mule deer
5 where a person may not hunt a mule deer unless the mule deer has at least three
6 points on at least one antler.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 501.105 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 501.105 **1.** The Commission shall establish policies and
3 adopt regulations necessary to the preservation, protection,
4 management and restoration of wildlife and its habitat.



- 1 2. In addition to any regulation adopted pursuant to
2 subsection 1, the Commission may adopt a regulation:
3 (a) Establishing an area for the management of mule deer;
4 and
5 (b) Prohibiting a person from hunting a mule deer within the
6 boundaries of the area unless the mule deer has at least three
7 points on at least one antler.
