SUMMARY—Makes appropriation to Aging Services Division of Department of Human Resources for establishment of pilot program to provide assistance to senior citizens for vision care. (BDR S-445)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Aging Services Division of the Department of Human Resources for the establishment of a pilot program to provide assistance to senior citizens for vision care; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Aging Services Division of the Department of
3 Human Resources the sum of \$200,000 for the establishment of a



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1 pilot program to provide assistance to senior citizens for vision care,
2 including eye examinations and eyeglasses, based on the criteria for
3 eligibility under the Senior Rx program.

4 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
5 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
6 June 30, 2007, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or
7 before September 21, 2007.

8 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.

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
