

**ASSEMBLY BILL No. 15—COMMITTEE ON
NATURAL RESOURCES, AGRICULTURE, AND MINING**

SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing expenditure of money in Wildlife Heritage Trust Account. (BDR 45-177)

AN ACT relating to wildlife; revising provisions governing the expenditure of money in the Wildlife Heritage Trust Account to authorize the expenditure of certain annual deposits; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law creates the Wildlife Heritage Trust Account in the State General Fund for use by the Department of Wildlife for the management of game fish, game birds and game and fur-bearing mammals. (NRS 501.3575) Existing law provides that the Account is funded by proceeds from wildlife drawings and through monetary gifts made to the Account. (NRS 502.250) Existing law limits the Department's annual expenditure from the Account to the total interest earned on the money in the Account during the previous year. (NRS 501.3575)

This bill amends existing law by expanding the authorized expenditures from the Account. This bill allows the Department to expend an amount of money not greater than 75 percent of the money deposited in the Account during the previous year and the total interest earned on the Account during the previous year.



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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 501.3575 is hereby amended to read as
2 follows:

3 501.3575 1. The Wildlife Heritage Trust Account is hereby
4 created in the State General Fund. The money in the Account must
5 be used by the Department as provided in this section for the
6 protection, propagation, restoration, transplantation, introduction
7 and management of any game fish, game mammal, game bird or fur-
8 bearing mammal in this State.

9 2. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 502.250, money
10 received by the Department from:

11 (a) A bid, auction or partnership in wildlife drawing conducted
12 pursuant to NRS 502.250; and

13 (b) A gift of money made by any person to the Wildlife Heritage
14 Trust Account,

15 → must be deposited with the State Treasurer for credit to the
16 Account.

17 3. The interest and income earned on the money in the Wildlife
18 Heritage Trust Account, after deducting any applicable charges,
19 must be credited to the Account.

20 4. The Department may annually expend from the Wildlife
21 Heritage Trust Account an amount of money not greater than **75**
percent of the money deposited in the Account pursuant to
subsection 2 during the previous year and the total amount of
22 interest earned on the money in the Account during the previous
23 year. The Commission shall review and approve expenditures from
24 the Account. No money may be expended from the Account without
25 the prior approval of the Commission.

26 5. The Commission shall administer the provisions of this
27 section and may adopt any regulations necessary for that purpose.
