SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing expenditure of money in Wildlife Heritage Trust Account. (BDR 45-177)

AN ACT relating to wildlife; expanding the purposes for which the money in the Wildlife Heritage Trust Account must be used to include expenditures for the management and control of predatory wildlife in this State; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law creates the Wildlife Heritage Trust Account in the State General
2 Fund for use by the Department of Wildlife for the management of game fish, game
3 birds and game and fur-bearing mammals. (NRS 501.3575) Existing law provides
4 that the Account is funded by proceeds from wildlife drawings and through
5 monetary gifts made to the Account. (NRS 502.250)

6 This bill amends existing law by expanding the purposes for which the money
7 in the Account must be used to include expenditures for the management and
8 control of predatory wildlife in this State.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 501.3575 is hereby amended to read as
2 follows:

3 501.3575 1. The Wildlife Heritage Trust Account is hereby
4 created in the State General Fund. The money in the Account must
5 be used by the Department as provided in this section for ~~[the]~~:

6 (a) **The** protection, propagation, restoration, transplantation,
7 introduction and management of any game fish, game mammal,
8 game bird or fur-bearing mammal in this State ~~H; and~~

9 (b) **The management and control of predatory wildlife in this
10 State.**

11 2. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 502.250, money
12 received by the Department from:

13 (a) A bid, auction or partnership in wildlife drawing conducted
14 pursuant to NRS 502.250; and

15 (b) A gift of money made by any person to the Wildlife Heritage
16 Trust Account,

17 → must be deposited with the State Treasurer for credit to the
18 Account.

19 3. The interest and income earned on the money in the Wildlife
20 Heritage Trust Account, after deducting any applicable charges,
21 must be credited to the Account.

22 4. The Department may annually expend from the Wildlife
23 Heritage Trust Account an amount of money not greater than the
24 interest earned on the money in the Account during the previous
25 year. The Commission shall review and approve expenditures from
26 the Account. No money may be expended from the Account without
27 the prior approval of the Commission.

28 5. The Commission shall administer the provisions of this
29 section and may adopt any regulations necessary for that purpose.
