

CHAPTER.....

AN ACT relating to attorneys; repealing the requirement that an attorney, other than a public defender or deputy public defender, appointed to represent an indigent defendant report to the State Public Defender concerning such representation; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

Existing law requires an attorney, other than a public defender or deputy public defender, who is appointed to represent an indigent defendant to report to the State Public Defender regarding the representation. (NRS 180.070)

This bill repeals that requirement.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NRS 180.070 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
