SUMMARY—Directs Department of Transportation to conduct study of need and feasibility of constructing certain arterial road for Interstate Highway No. 95 in Las Vegas, Nevada. (BDR S-1174)

AN ACT relating to public highways; directing the Department of Transportation to conduct a study of the need and feasibility of constructing an arterial road and access to that road between Interstate Highway No. 95 and North Hollywood Boulevard in Las Vegas, Nevada; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

- 1 Existing law authorizes the Department of Transportation to construct, improve
 - 2 and maintain the state highway system. (NRS 408.285, 408.313-408.433)
 - 3 This bill directs the Department of Transportation to conduct a study to
 - 4 determine whether an arterial road directly connecting Interstate Highway No. 95 to
 - 5 North Hollywood Boulevard in Las Vegas should be constructed. The study must
 - 6 also determine whether access to such a road from certain surrounding streets is
 - 7 necessary.
 - 8 The Director of the Department of Transportation must submit a report of the
 - 9 results of the study to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for
 - 10 transmission to the 74th Session of the Nevada Legislature.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 1. The Department of Transportation shall conduct a study to determine whether an arterial road should be constructed that would directly connect Interstate Highway No. 95 to North Hollywood Boulevard in the City of Las Vegas, Nevada. The study must include, without limitation:

(a) An analysis of the cost and feasibility of constructing the road.

(b) A determination of whether access to the road from surrounding streets between Interstate Highway No. 95 and North Hollywood Boulevard, including, without limitation, Lamb Boulevard, Nellis Boulevard and Sloan Lane, is necessary and, if so, an analysis of the cost and feasibility of providing that access.

(c) A proposed schedule by which the road could reasonably be constructed and completed.

(d) An identification of any available sources of money that could be used to construct the road.

2. The Director of the Department of Transportation shall submit a report of the results of the study conducted pursuant to subsection 1 and any recommendations resulting from the study to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmittal to the 74th Session of the Legislature.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.
