SUMMARY—Requires local and regional governmental entities to conduct study of safe walking routes in certain area near schools. (BDR S-262)

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AN ACT relating to public schools; requiring local and regional governmental entities to conduct a study of safe walking routes for pupils in a certain area near schools; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

1        WHEREAS, There are over 385,000 pupils in the public school  
2 system in the State of Nevada; and

3        WHEREAS, Pupils who live within 2 miles of the school that they  
4 attend are not eligible for transportation by bus to and from school,  
5 and therefore many of those pupils must walk both ways; and

6        WHEREAS, The safety of pupils walking between their homes  
7 and their schools is of critical importance to the community; and

8        WHEREAS, The existence of paved walking paths and well-  
9 maintained sidewalks increases the safety of those pupils; and

10      WHEREAS, Safe walking paths and sidewalks may also  
11 encourage more pupils to walk to and from school, thus promoting  
12 their overall health; and

13      WHEREAS, Both school districts and local governments play an  
14 integral role in ensuring the safety of pupils as they travel to and  
15 from school; and

1        WHEREAS, An effective way of ensuring the safety of pupils is  
2 to encourage school districts and local governments to cooperate in  
3 developing safe walking routes and improving the conditions of  
4 walking paths and sidewalks for pupils; now, therefore,

6        THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
7                   SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

9        **Section 1.** 1. In a county whose population is 100,000 or  
10 more, the regional planning coalition created pursuant to NRS  
11 278.02514 and the regional planning commission created pursuant  
12 to NRS 278.0262 shall each, in conjunction with the county school  
13 district and other local governments in the county, conduct a study  
14 of safe walking routes for pupils to public schools in the county.

15        2. The study must include, without limitation:

16              (a) A review and evaluation of the existing walking paths and  
17 sidewalks within a 1-mile radius of each public school located in the  
18 county;

19              (b) Recommendations for improvements to the conditions of  
20 those walking paths and sidewalks; and

21              (c) A review and evaluation of the programs currently  
22 implemented in the county to ensure safe walking routes for pupils  
23 to schools.

24        3. The regional planning coalition and regional planning  
25 commission shall each submit a report of the results of its study to  
26 the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmittal to the  
27 74th Session of the Nevada Legislature.

28        **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.

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
