AN ACT making an appropriation to the Office of the Attorney General for the start-up costs of the quarterly publication of the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Office of the Attorney General the sum of
3 \$50,000 for the start-up costs of the quarterly publication of the
4 National Center for Missing and Exploited Children.
5 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
6 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
7 June 30, 2007, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or
8 before September 21, 2007.
9 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.
