AN ACT relating to state financial administration; requiring the Legislative Auditor, if he finds evidence of willful noncompliance with applicable laws or regulations, to report that noncompliance to the Governor, each member of the Legislature and the Attorney General; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 218.880 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 218.880 1. If the Legislative Auditor finds, in the course of
3 his audit, evidence of improper practices of financial administration
4 or inadequacy of fiscal records, he shall report these practices
5 immediately to the Governor, each member of the Legislature and
6 the head of the agency affected.

7 2. If the Legislative Auditor finds evidence of illegal
8 transactions, he shall forthwith report these transactions to the
9 Governor, each member of the Legislature and the Attorney
10 General.

11 ***3. If the Legislative Auditor finds evidence of willful
12 noncompliance with any applicable law or regulation, he shall
13 report this noncompliance to the Governor, each member of the
14 Legislature and the Attorney General.***
