AN ACT relating to public highways; requiring the Department of Transportation to construct sound barriers along a portion of U.S. Interstate No. 95 in Clark County; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** The Department of Transportation shall construct
2 or cause to be constructed walls to function as sound barriers, where
3 such barriers do not already exist, along U.S. Interstate No. 95 in
4 Clark County between Las Vegas Boulevard and Charleston
5 Boulevard.

6 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.
