SUMMARY—Requires Clark County School District to construct vocational-technical high school. (BDR S-1125)

AN ACT relating to public schools; requiring the Clark County School District to construct a vocational-technical high school within the boundaries of Assembly District 6; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

- 1 Existing law authorizes the board of trustees of a school district to use money
2 in the county school district fund for the construction and repair of school
3 buildings. (NRS 387.205)
4 This bill requires the Clark County School District to construct a vocational-
5 technical high school within the boundaries of Assembly District 6. The school
6 must be completed by July 1, 2008, and be open for enrollment to all pupils
7 enrolled in the school district who are eligible for enrollment in high school.
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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** The Clark County School District shall construct
2 one vocational-technical high school within the boundaries of
3 Assembly District 6. The school must:
4 1. Be completed not later than July 1, 2008.



1 2. Be open for enrollment to all pupils enrolled in the Clark
2 County School District who are eligible for enrollment in high
3 school.

4 **Sec. 2.** The provisions of NRS 354.599 do not apply to any
5 additional expenses of a local government that are related to the
6 provisions of this act.

7 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
