SUMMARY—Names Chapel at Southern Nevada Veterans Memorial Cemetery the Ken Brown Chapel. (BDR S-817)

AN ACT relating to the Southern Nevada Veterans Memorial Cemetery; naming the Chapel at the Cemetery the Ken Brown Chapel; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

- 1 Existing law established a veterans' cemetery in northern Nevada and a
- 2 veterans' cemetery in southern Nevada. (NRS 417.200)
- 3 This bill names the chapel at the Southern Nevada Veterans Memorial
- 4 Cemetery in Boulder City, Nevada, the Ken Brown Chapel in recognition of the
- 5 man who donated the land on which the Cemetery is located. The Executive
- 6 Director for Veterans' Services is required to mark the Chapel with appropriate
- 7 signage to indicate the name of the Chapel.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. The Chapel at the Southern Nevada Veterans
- 2 Memorial Cemetery in Boulder City, Nevada, is hereby named the
- 3 Ken Brown Chapel, in recognition of the man who donated the 83.5
- 4 acres of land on which the Cemetery is located.
- 5 2. The Executive Director for Veterans' Services shall mark
- 6 the Chapel with appropriate signage to indicate the name designated
- 7 pursuant to subsection 1.
