
ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 3—ASSEMBLYMAN CLABORN**PREFILED JANUARY 26, 2005**

Referred to Committee on Natural Resources,
Agriculture, and Mining

SUMMARY—Requires Legislative Auditor to conduct performance audit of Department of Wildlife. (BDR S-493)

AN ACT relating to the Department of Wildlife; requiring the Legislative Auditor to conduct a performance audit of the Department; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law gives the Legislative Auditor the duty and authority to perform
2 audits of state agencies on a rotating basis. (NRS 218.737-218.893)

3 This bill would require the Legislative Auditor to conduct a performance audit
4 of the Department of Wildlife. The bill requires that the audit report be submitted to
5 the Audit Subcommittee of the Legislative Commission on or before the first day of
6 the 2007 Legislative Session.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. The Legislative Auditor shall conduct a
2 performance audit of the Department of Wildlife.
3 2. The Legislative Auditor shall prepare a written report of the
4 performance audit and present the report to the Audit Subcommittee
5 of the Legislative Commission not later than February 5, 2007.
6 3. The provisions of NRS 218.737 to 218.893, inclusive, apply
7 to the performance audit conducted pursuant to this section.



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1 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.

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
