AN ACT making an appropriation to provide assistance in rent for
low-income families; and providing other matters
properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
- 2 General Fund to the Account for Low-Income Housing, created by
- 3 NRS 319.500, the sum of \$2,000,000 to provide assistance in rent
- 4 for low-income families.
- 5 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
- 6 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
- 7 June 30, 2007, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or
- 8 before September 21, 2007.
- 9 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.
