

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 346—ASSEMBLYMEN GRADY
AND OCEGUERA (BY REQUEST)

MARCH 22, 2005

Referred to Committee on Government Affairs

SUMMARY—Authorizes State Fire Marshal to adopt certain regulations relating to use of fire by fire departments in providing training to firemen. (BDR 42-276)

AN ACT relating to fire protection; authorizing the State Fire Marshal to adopt certain regulations relating to the use of fire by fire departments in providing training to firemen; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 477.030 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 477.030 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section, the
3 State Fire Marshal shall enforce all laws and adopt regulations
4 relating to:
5 (a) The prevention of fire.
6 (b) The storage and use of:
7 (1) Combustibles, flammables and fireworks; and
8 (2) Explosives in any commercial construction, but not in
9 mining or the control of avalanches,
10 → under those circumstances that are not otherwise regulated by the
11 Division of Industrial Relations of the Department of Business and
12 Industry pursuant to NRS 618.890.
13 (c) The safety, access, means and adequacy of exit in case of fire
14 from mental and penal institutions, facilities for the care of children,
15 foster homes, residential facilities for groups, facilities for
16 intermediate care, nursing homes, hospitals, schools, all buildings,



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1 except private residences, which are occupied for sleeping purposes,
2 buildings used for public assembly and all other buildings where
3 large numbers of persons work, live or congregate for any purpose.
4 As used in this paragraph, "public assembly" means a building or a
5 portion of a building used for the gathering together of 50 or more
6 persons for purposes of deliberation, education, instruction, worship,
7 entertainment, amusement or awaiting transportation, or the
8 gathering together of 100 or more persons in establishments for
9 drinking or dining.

10 (d) The suppression and punishment of arson and fraudulent
11 claims or practices in connection with fire losses.

12 ➔ The regulations of the State Fire Marshal apply throughout the
13 State, but, except with respect to state-owned or state-occupied
14 buildings, his authority to enforce them or conduct investigations
15 under this chapter does not extend to a county whose population is
16 100,000 or more or which has been converted into a consolidated
17 municipality, except in those local jurisdictions in those counties
18 where he is requested to exercise that authority by the chief officer
19 of the organized fire department of that jurisdiction ~~H~~ or except as
20 otherwise provided in a regulation adopted pursuant to paragraph
21 (b) of subsection 2.

22 2. The State Fire Marshal may ~~set~~ :

23 (a) Set standards for equipment and appliances pertaining to fire
24 safety or to be used for fire protection within this State, including
25 the threads used on fire hose couplings and hydrant fittings ~~H~~; and

26 (b) Adopt regulations setting forth the requirements for fire
27 departments to provide training to firemen using techniques or
28 exercises that involve the use of fire or any device that produces or
29 may be used to produce fire.

30 3. The State Fire Marshal shall cooperate with the State
31 Forester Firewarden in the preparation of regulations relating to
32 standards for fire retardant roofing materials pursuant to paragraph
33 (e) of subsection 1 of NRS 472.040.

34 4. The State Fire Marshal shall cooperate with the Division of
35 Child and Family Services of the Department of Human Resources
36 in establishing reasonable minimum standards for overseeing the
37 safety of and directing the means and adequacy of exit in case of fire
38 from family foster homes and group foster homes.

39 5. The State Fire Marshal shall coordinate all activities
40 conducted pursuant to 15 U.S.C. §§ 2201 et seq. and receive and
41 distribute money allocated by the United States pursuant to that act.

42 6. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 10, the State Fire
43 Marshal shall:

44 (a) Investigate any fire which occurs in a county other than one
45 whose population is 100,000 or more or which has been converted



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1 into a consolidated municipality, and from which a death results or
2 which is of a suspicious nature.

3 (b) Investigate any fire which occurs in a county whose
4 population is 100,000 or more or which has been converted into a
5 consolidated municipality, and from which a death results or which
6 is of a suspicious nature, if requested to do so by the chief officer of
7 the fire department in whose jurisdiction the fire occurs.

8 (c) Cooperate with the Commissioner of Insurance, the Attorney
9 General and the Fraud Control Unit established pursuant to NRS
10 228.412 in any investigation of a fraudulent claim under an
11 insurance policy for any fire of a suspicious nature.

12 (d) Cooperate with any local fire department in the investigation
13 of any report received pursuant to NRS 629.045.

14 (e) Provide specialized training in investigating the causes of
15 fires if requested to do so by the chief officer of an organized fire
16 department.

17 7. The State Fire Marshal shall put the National Fire Incident
18 Reporting System into effect throughout the State and publish at
19 least annually a summary of data collected under the System.

20 8. The State Fire Marshal shall provide assistance and
21 materials to local authorities, upon request, for the establishment of
22 programs for public education and other fire prevention activities.

23 9. The State Fire Marshal shall:

24 (a) Assist in checking plans and specifications for construction;
25 (b) Provide specialized training to local fire departments; and
26 (c) Assist local governments in drafting regulations and
27 ordinances,

28 → on request or as he deems necessary.

29 10. ~~If~~ Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, in a
30 county other than one whose population is 100,000 or more or
31 which has been converted into a consolidated municipality, the State
32 Fire Marshal shall, upon request by a local government, delegate to
33 the local government by interlocal agreement all or a portion of his
34 authority or duties if the local government's personnel and programs
35 are, as determined by the State Fire Marshal, equally qualified to
36 perform those functions. If a local government fails to maintain the
37 qualified personnel and programs in accordance with such an
38 agreement, the State Fire Marshal shall revoke the agreement. **The**
39 **provisions of this subsection do not apply to the authority of the**
40 **State Fire Marshal to adopt regulations pursuant to paragraph (b)**
41 **of subsection 2.**
