

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 391—ASSEMBLYMAN PERKINS

SUMMARY—Makes appropriation to Department of Education for disbursement to elementary school teachers for classroom supplies. (BDR S-1073)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Education for disbursement to elementary school teachers for classroom supplies; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Department of Education the sum of
3 \$5,645,000 for disbursement to school districts to provide a \$500
4 reimbursement check to each elementary school teacher for
5 purchasing classroom supplies.
6 **Sec. 2.** 1. On or before August 1, 2005, each school district
7 in Nevada must apply to the Department of Education to receive
8 reimbursement for the purchase of classroom supplies by
9 elementary school teachers in the school district.
10 2. Upon receipt of the application, the Department of
11 Education shall disburse \$500 per elementary school teacher to the
12 school district on or before September 1, 2005.
13 **Sec. 3.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
14 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
15 June 30, 2006, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or
16 before September 15, 2006.



1 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.
