**SUMMARY**—Makes appropriation for statewide parental involvement and communications consultant. (BDR S-837)

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AN ACT relating to education; making an appropriation to the Department of Education for a statewide parental involvement and communications consultant; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1       **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State  
2 General Fund to the Department of Education the following sums  
3 for a statewide parental involvement and communications  
4 consultant:
- 5              For the Fiscal Year 2005-2006..... \$84,000  
6              For the Fiscal Year 2006-2007..... \$105,000
- 7       2. The Department of Education shall use the money  
8 appropriated by subsection 1 to pay the salary, benefits and  
9 expenses of a qualified statewide parental involvement and  
10 communications consultant. The consultant shall:  
11              (a) Work in cooperation with the 17 school districts to develop  
12 and carry out programs, consistent with the policy adopted by the  
13 State Board of Education pursuant to NRS 392.457, that are



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1 designed to increase effective involvement by parents and families  
2 in support of their children and the education of their children and to  
3 increase effective communication by parents and families with their  
4 children's teachers and other school personnel; and

5       (b) Provide support and advice to the 17 school districts  
6 concerning effective measures to carry out the policies adopted by  
7 the school districts pursuant to NRS 392.457.

8       3. The Department of Education shall submit:

9       (a) An interim written report on or before September 1, 2006, to  
10 the Legislative Committee on Education.

11       (b) A final written report on or before February 1, 2007, to the  
12 Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmission to the  
13 74th Session of the Nevada Legislature.

14       4. Each report required by subsection 3 must include, without  
15 limitation:

16       (a) A description of the duties carried out by the consultant;

17       (b) A description of the programs developed by the consultant to  
18 increase effective involvement by parents and families in support of  
19 their children and the education of their children and to increase  
20 effective communication by parents and families with their  
21 children's teachers and other school personnel, including, without  
22 limitation, a description of the manner in which those programs  
23 were carried out by the 17 school districts; and

24       (c) An evaluation of the effect of the services performed by the  
25 consultant and the programs developed by the consultant on the  
26 involvement of parents and families in support of their children and  
27 the education of their children and on the communication of parents  
28 and families with their children's teachers and other school  
29 personnel.

30       5. Any balance of the sums appropriated by subsection 1  
31 remaining at the end of the respective fiscal years must not be  
32 committed for expenditure after June 30 of the respective fiscal  
33 years and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before  
34 September 15, 2006, and September 21, 2007, respectively.

35       **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.
