

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 399—ASSEMBLYMAN SHERER
(BY REQUEST)

Referred to Committee on Education

SUMMARY—Requires instruction in flag etiquette in public schools. (BDR 34-500)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: May have Fiscal Impact.
Effect on the State: Yes.

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EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to education; requiring the State Board of Education to prescribe instruction in flag etiquette; requiring each public school to set aside appropriate time each school year for instruction in flag etiquette; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 389.040 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 389.040 **1.** Each public school shall set aside appropriate
3 time at the beginning of each school day for pupils to pledge their
4 allegiance to the flag of the United States. In addition, each public
5 school may set aside appropriate time during the school day for
6 additional patriotic observance.

7 **2. The State Board shall adopt regulations that prescribe
8 instruction in flag etiquette for the flag of the United States
9 consistent with the Federal Flag Code, 4 U.S.C. Chapter 1. The
10 regulations must:**

- 11 (b) ***Include, without limitation, the proper:***
12 (1) ***Respect for the flag;***
13 (2) ***Uses of the flag;***
14 (3) ***Storage of the flag;***
15 (4) ***Cleaning and mending of the flag;***



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1 (5) *Position and manner of display of the flag, including,*
2 *without limitation, display of the flag outdoors and display of the*
3 *flag indoors;*

4 (6) *Times and occasions for display of the flag; and*

5 (7) *Retirement of the flag.*

6 (b) *Designate the amount of time during the school year that*
7 *must be devoted to flag etiquette, as appropriate for each grade*
8 *level.*

9 3. *Each public school shall set aside the appropriate amount*
10 *of time each school year to ensure that the pupils enrolled in the*
11 *school receive instruction in flag etiquette, as prescribed by the*
12 *State Board pursuant to subsection 2.*

13 Sec. 2. 1. On or before November 1, 2005, the State Board
14 of Education shall adopt regulations prescribing the instruction in
15 flag etiquette pursuant to section 1 of this act.

16 2. Each public school shall comply with section 1 of this act
17 commencing with the 2005-2006 school year to the extent such
18 compliance is practicable after the adoption of the regulations by the
19 State Board of Education.

20 Sec. 3. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.

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
