AN ACT making an appropriation for the support of the Mental Health Court in Clark County; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** The Legislature hereby finds and declares that:  
2         1. According to the Bureau of Justice Statistics of the United  
3         States Department of Justice, over 16 percent of adults incarcerated  
4         in the jails and prisons in the United States have a mental illness;  
5         2. According to the National Alliance for the Mentally Ill, up  
6         to 40 percent of adults who suffer from a serious mental illness will  
7         come into contact with the American criminal justice system at  
8         some point in their lives;  
9         3. A significant proportion of adults with a serious mental  
10        illness who are involved with the criminal justice system are  
11        homeless or at imminent risk of becoming homeless and many of  
12        these persons are arrested and jailed for minor, nonviolent offenses;  
13         4. The majority of persons with a mental illness or emotional  
14        disorder who are involved in the criminal or juvenile justice system  
15        are responsive to medical and psychological interventions that  
16        integrate treatment, rehabilitation and support services; and

1       5. Collaborative programs between mental health, substance  
2 abuse and criminal or juvenile justice systems that ensure the  
3 provision of services for those with mental illness or co-occurring  
4 mental illness and substance abuse disorders can reduce the number  
5 of such persons in adult and juvenile correctional facilities while  
6 providing improved public safety.

7       **Sec. 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General  
8 Fund to the Southern Nevada Adult Mental Health Services of the  
9 Division of Mental Health and Developmental Services of the  
10 Department of Human Resources for the support of the Mental  
11 Health Court in Clark County:

12             For the Fiscal Year 2005-2006.....\$1,000,000  
13             For the Fiscal Year 2006-2007.....\$1,000,000

14       **Sec. 3.** Any balance of the sums appropriated by section 2 of  
15 this act remaining at the end of the respective fiscal years must not  
16 be committed for expenditure after June 30 of the respective fiscal  
17 years and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before  
18 September 21, 2007.

19       **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
