

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 460—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

MARCH 28, 2005

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Referred to Committee on Ways and Means

**SUMMARY**—Makes appropriation to Clark County Public Education Foundation for continuation of current programs and expansion of outreach efforts. (BDR S-826)

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AN ACT making an appropriation to the Clark County Public Education Foundation for continuation of current programs and expansion of outreach efforts; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State  
2 General Fund to the Clark County Public Education Foundation,  
3 Inc., the sum of \$600,000 for the continuation of current programs  
4 and the expansion of outreach efforts.

5       **Sec. 2.** Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by section  
6 1 of this act, the Clark County Public Education Foundation, Inc.,  
7 shall:

8       1. Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance  
9 Committee on or before December 15, 2006, that describes each  
10 expenditure made from the money appropriated by section 1 of this  
11 act from the date on which the money was received by the Clark  
12 County Public Education Foundation, Inc., through December 1,  
13 2006; and

14       2. Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available  
15 to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims,



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1 reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or  
2 otherwise of the Clark County Public Education Foundation, Inc.,  
3 regardless of their form or location, that the Legislative Auditor  
4 deems necessary to conduct an audit of the use of the money  
5 appropriated pursuant to section 1 of this act.

6       **Sec. 3.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by  
7 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after  
8 June 30, 2007, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or  
9 before September 21, 2007.

10      **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.

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
