AN ACT relating to elected state officers; increasing the salaries of certain constitutional officers; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** NRS 223.050 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2       223.050 Until the first Monday in January ***[\$1999,] 2007,*** the  
3 Governor is entitled to receive an annual salary of ***[\$90,000,]***  
4 ***\$117,000.*** From and after the first Monday in January ***[\$1999,] 2007,***  
5 the Governor is entitled to receive an annual salary of ***[\$117,000,]***  
6 ***\$141,000.***

7       **Sec. 2.** NRS 224.050 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
8       224.050 1. Until the first Monday in January ***[\$1999,] 2007,***  
9 the Lieutenant Governor is entitled to receive an annual salary of  
10 ***[\$20,000,]*** ***\$50,000.*** From and after the first Monday in January  
11 ***[\$1999,] 2007,*** the Lieutenant Governor is entitled to receive an  
12 annual salary of ***[\$50,000,]*** ***\$60,000.***

13       2. In addition to the annual salary provided for in subsection 1,  
14 the Lieutenant Governor is entitled to receive the compensation  
15 provided for a majority of the members of the Legislature during the  
16 first 60 days of the session and the per diem allowance and travel  
17 expenses authorized for the members of the Legislature.

18       3. In addition to the salary provided in subsections 1 and 2, the  
19 Lieutenant Governor is entitled to receive \$130 for each day on

1 which he is actually employed as Governor and the per diem  
2 allowance and travel expenses as provided for state officers and  
3 employees generally when acting as Governor, or when discharging  
4 other official duties as Lieutenant Governor, at times when the  
5 Legislature is not in session.

6       **Sec. 3.** NRS 225.050 is hereby amended to read as follows:

7       225.050 Until the first Monday in January ~~1999,~~ **2007**, the  
8 Secretary of State is entitled to receive an annual salary of  
9 ~~\$62,500,~~ **\$80,000.** From and after the first Monday in January  
10 ~~1999,~~ **2007**, the Secretary of State is entitled to receive an annual  
11 salary of ~~\$80,000,~~ **\$97,000.**

12       **Sec. 4.** NRS 226.090 is hereby amended to read as follows:

13       226.090 Until the first Monday in January ~~1999,~~ **2007**, the  
14 State Treasurer is entitled to receive an annual salary of ~~\$62,500,~~  
15 **\$80,000.** From and after the first Monday in January ~~1999,~~ **2007**,  
16 the State Treasurer is entitled to receive an annual salary of  
17 ~~\$80,000,~~ **\$97,000.**

18       **Sec. 5.** NRS 227.060 is hereby amended to read as follows:

19       227.060 Until the first Monday in January ~~1999,~~ **2007**, the  
20 State Controller is entitled to receive an annual salary of ~~\$62,500,~~  
21 **\$80,000.** From and after the first Monday in January ~~1999,~~ **2007**,  
22 the State Controller is entitled to receive an annual salary of  
23 ~~\$80,000,~~ **\$97,000.**

24       **Sec. 6.** NRS 228.070 is hereby amended to read as follows:

25       228.070 1. Until the first Monday in January ~~1999,~~ **2007**,  
26 the Attorney General is entitled to receive an annual salary of  
27 ~~\$85,000,~~ **\$110,000.** From and after the first Monday in January  
28 ~~1999,~~ **2007**, the Attorney General is entitled to receive an annual  
29 salary of ~~\$110,000,~~ **\$133,000.**

30       2. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 7.065, the Attorney  
31 General shall not engage in the private practice of law.
