AN ACT relating to criminal procedure; removing the provision which requires corroboration to prove certain crimes relating to prostitution; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 175.301 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 175.301 Upon a trial for procuring or attempting to procure an
3 abortion, or aiding or assisting therein, ~~for for inveigling, enticing or~~
4 ~~taking away any person for the purpose of prostitution, or aiding or~~
5 ~~assisting therein,~~ the defendant must not be convicted upon the
6 testimony of the person upon or with whom the offense has
7 allegedly been committed, unless:
8 1. The testimony of that person is corroborated by other
9 evidence; or
10 2. The person giving the testimony is, and was at the time the
11 crime is alleged to have taken place, a police officer or deputy
12 sheriff who was performing his duties as such.
