AN ACT relating to tourism; authorizing the Executive Director of the Commission on Tourism to provide for the release and use of official publications of the Commission and certain information in the records and files of the Commission; authoring the Executive Director to charge and collect reasonable fees for the release and use of such publications and information; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 231.240 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 231.240 1. The Executive Director of the Commission on
3 Tourism may charge **and collect** reasonable fees for ~~materials~~
4 ~~prepared for distribution.~~ :
5 **(a) Official publications of the Commission and materials**
6 **prepared by the Commission for distribution; and**
7 **(b) The release, in accordance with subsections 3, 4 and 5, of**
8 **information in the files and records of the Commission or its**
9 **divisions that was obtained from persons who have contacted or**



1 *submitted inquiries to the Commission relating to travel or tourism*
2 *in this State.*

3 2. All such fees must be deposited with the State Treasurer for
4 credit to the Commission. The fees must first be expended
5 exclusively for materials and labor incident to preparing ~~and~~
6 ~~printing those materials for distribution.~~ , *printing or otherwise*
7 *making available those publications, files and records.* Any
8 remaining fees may be expended, in addition to any other money
9 appropriated, for the support of the Commission.

10 3. *Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the*
11 *Executive Director may release information from the publications,*
12 *files and records of the Commission or its divisions to a person or*
13 *a governmental entity that provides a description of the*
14 *information requested and its proposed use and signs an affidavit*
15 *to that effect. The Executive Director may deny a request for*
16 *information pursuant to this subsection if he reasonably believes*
17 *that the information taken may be used for an unauthorized*
18 *purpose or an unwarranted invasion of the privacy of a person.*

19 4. *Before the Executive Director releases information*
20 *pursuant to subsection 3, he must adopt policies and procedures to*
21 *ensure that:*

22 (a) *The information will be used or sold only for use in the*
23 *distribution of surveys, marketing material or solicitations to*
24 *benefit tourism in Nevada;*

25 (b) *Each person about whom the information is requested has*
26 *clearly been provided with an opportunity to authorize such a use;*
27 *and*

28 (c) *If the person about whom the information is requested does*
29 *not authorize such a use, the distribution will not be directed*
30 *toward that person.*

31 5. *A person or governmental entity that receives information*
32 *pursuant to subsection 3 shall not sell or disclose that information*
33 *to another person or governmental entity.*

34 6. *The Commission shall adopt such regulations as it*
35 *determines to be necessary or advisable to carry out the provisions*
36 *of this section.*
