SUMMARY—Prohibits managed care organizations from requiring providers of health care to assume financial risk for costs of acquiring immunizations for children under certain circumstances. (BDR 57-791)

AN ACT relating to health insurance; prohibiting managed care organizations from requiring providers of health care to assume the financial risk for the costs of acquiring immunizations for children under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 695G of NRS is hereby amended by
2 adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 *A managed care organization shall not require a provider of*
4 *health care to assume the financial risk for the costs of acquiring*
5 *immunizations for children as a condition of entering into or*
6 *renewing a contract for the provision of health care services with*
7 *the managed care organization.*

8 **Sec. 2.** The provisions of this act apply to all contracts for the
9 provision of health care services entered into or renewed on or after
10 October 1, 2005.
