

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 557—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

AN ACT making an appropriation for the continuation of Project Safe Neighborhoods; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Department of Administration for allocation to
3 Project Safe Neighborhoods the sum of \$250,000 for continuation of
4 its programs to assist at-risk youth in social skills and to discourage
5 the use of weapons.
6 2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,
7 Project Safe Neighborhoods shall:
8 (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance
9 Committee on or before December 15, 2006, that describes each
10 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
11 from the date on which the money was received by Project Safe
12 Neighborhoods through December 1, 2006; and
13 (b) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available
14 to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims,
15 reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or
16 otherwise, of Project Safe Neighborhoods, irrespective of their form
17 or location, that the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct



1 an audit of the use of the money appropriated pursuant to
2 subsection 1.

3 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
4 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
5 June 30, 2007, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or
6 before September 21, 2007.

7 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
