

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 564—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

Referred to Committee on Ways and Means

SUMMARY—Makes appropriation to Have A Peaceful Heart Foundation for assistance with merchandising that will help finance establishment of new music educational programs in Clark County School District. (BDR S-1442)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Have A Peaceful Heart Foundation for assistance with merchandising that will help finance the establishment of new music educational programs in the Clark County School District; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
- 2 General Fund to the Have A Peaceful Heart Foundation the sum of
- 3 \$500,000 for assistance with merchandising that will help finance
- 4 the establishment of new music educational programs in the Clark
- 5 County School District.
- 6 2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,
- 7 the Have A Peaceful Heart Foundation agrees to:
- 8 (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance
- 9 Committee on or before December 15, 2006, that describes each
- 10 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
- 11 from the date on which the money was received by the Have A
- 12 Peaceful Heart Foundation through December 1, 2006; and



(b) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims, reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or otherwise, of the Have A Peaceful Heart Foundation, regardless of their form or location, that the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct an audit of the use of the money appropriated pursuant to subsection 1.

Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2007, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 21, 2007.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
