AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for the costs of terminal leave, tort insurance premiums paid by the Division of Conservation Districts and updating joint funding agreements between the United States Geological Survey and the Division of Water Resources; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the State Department of Conservation and Natural
3 Resources the sum of \$93,972 for an unanticipated shortfall in
4 money for Fiscal Year 2004-2005 to be allocated as follows:
5 For costs of terminal leave \$42,460
6 For costs of tort insurance premiums paid by
7 the Division of
8 Conservation Districts \$36,532



1 For the updating of joint funding agreements
2 between the United States Geological
3 Survey and the Division of Water
4 Resources \$14,980
