ASSEMBLY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION—Recognizing the
contributions of the Hellenic Macedonian people to the
creation, preservation and enhancement of the Hellenic
culture of Greece throughout the world.

1 WHEREAS, Archeological evidence reveals that old European
2 civilization flourished in Macedonia between 7000 and 3500 B.C.
3 and the name “Macedonia” is the oldest surviving name of a country
4 on the continent of Europe; and

5 WHEREAS, Throughout its history, the present-day Greek
6 territory of Macedonia has been a crossroads for both traders and



1 conquerors moving between the European continent and Asia Minor
2 and each of these transiting powers left its mark on the region,
3 giving rise to a rich and varied cultural and historical tradition; and

4 WHEREAS, The first Greeks arrived in the area in approximately
5 2500 B.C. and, in conjunction with their settlements along the
6 coastline of the Aegean Sea, settled the interior and influenced the
7 art and politics of Macedonia; and

8 WHEREAS, Philip II raised Macedonia into a great European
9 power and his ancient kingdom reached its height during the reign
10 of Alexander the Great, who extended Macedonia's influence over
11 most of Asia Minor, the Levant, Egypt, Mesopotamia, Persia, and
12 even parts of India, and produced a lasting extension of Greek
13 culture and thought across the ancient Near East; and

14 WHEREAS, During the centuries of occupation by the Romans
15 and then the Turks, the Hellenic Macedonian people clung fiercely
16 to their Hellenistic character and beliefs and carried them into their
17 society today; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE
19 SENATE CONCURRING, That the members of the 73rd Session of the
20 Nevada Legislature hereby recognize the contributions of the
21 Hellenic Macedonian people to the creation, preservation and
22 enhancement of the Hellenic culture of Greece throughout the
23 world.
