ASSEMBLY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION—Requesting the Nevada Supreme Court to review the manner in which district courts receive and decide petitions to open files and records of the courts in adoption proceedings and to report its findings to the Legislature.

1        WHEREAS, The files and records of a court in adoption  
2        proceedings are confidential and thus are not open to inspection by  
3        any person except upon an order of the court pursuant to a petition  
4        setting forth the specific reasons therefor; and

5        WHEREAS, The Subcommittee on Adoption created by the  
6        Legislative Committee on Children, Youth and Families heard  
7        testimony that the process for seeking such an order from a court is  
8        unclear and unduly burdensome; and

9        WHEREAS, The files and records of the court in adoption  
10      proceedings may include important medical history and other  
11      medical information that could assist adopted persons and their  
12      adoptive families in making critical medical decisions; now,  
13      therefore, be it

14      RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE  
15      SENATE CONCURRING, That the Legislature hereby requests the  
16      Nevada Supreme Court to review the manner in which district
