2 friend and partner of the State of Nevada in an enduring sister-state
3 relationship for 20 years; and
4 WHEREAS, For more than 3 years, the Taipei Economic and
5 Cultural Office in San Francisco has operated successfully under the
6 guidance of the highly respected Director General Matthew S. Lee;
7 and
8 WHEREAS, Upon assuming the position of Director General of
9 the Taipei Economic and Cultural Office in San Francisco, Director
10 General Matthew S. Lee quickly became a good friend of the State
11 of Nevada, strengthening the bond that has grown with each passing
12 year; and
13 WHEREAS, Among his many accomplishments during his term
14 at the Taipei Economic and Cultural Office, Director General
15 Matthew S. Lee has helped strengthen the relationship between the
16 Republic of China on Taiwan and the State of Nevada; and



1 WHEREAS, Before his departure on June 10, 2005, to assume the
2 position of Representative of the Taipei Mission to Latvia, Director
3 General Matthew S. Lee will be honored in a number of receptions
4 to be held in appreciation for his dedication, cooperation and
5 exceptional leadership; and

6 WHEREAS, On June 11, 2005, the honorable Mark W. P. Liao
7 will assume the position of Director General of the Taipei Economic
8 and Cultural Office in San Francisco; and

9 WHEREAS, Mark W. P. Liao's educational background includes
10 a Bachelor of Arts degree from National Chengchi University in
11 Taiwan and a Master of Science in Foreign Service degree from
12 Georgetown University, and he also was a visiting scholar at
13 Stanford University; and

14 WHEREAS, In addition to his outstanding educational
15 background, Mark W. P. Liao has had a distinguished career with
16 the Republic of China on Taiwan, including serving as Director
17 General in Auckland, New Zealand, Director of Political Affairs in
18 the United Kingdom, Secretary General of the NGO Affairs
19 Committee with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and, most recently,
20 3 years as the Deputy Director General of the Taipei Economic and
21 Cultural Office in San Francisco; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE
23 SENATE CONCURRING, That the Nevada Legislature hereby
24 expresses its appreciation for the outstanding efforts made by
25 Director General Matthew S. Lee to further an understanding
