“Requiring an applicant for a special qualifications license to:

(I) Pass each examination required by NRS 391.021 for the specific subject or subjects in which the applicant will provide instruction; or

(II) Hold a valid license issued by a professional licensing board of any state that is directly related to the subject area of the master’s degree or doctoral degree held by the applicant. (9)”.

Amend the bill as a whole by deleting sec. 3 and renumbering sections 4 through 6 as sections 2 through 4.

A.B. No. 206—Provides for issuance of special license for persons with certain graduate degrees and work experience to teach pupils in public schools.

**If this amendment is adopted, the Legislative
Counsel's Digest will be changed to read as follows:**

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law establishes the kinds of licenses required for teachers and other educational personnel. The existing licenses are a license to teach elementary education, a license to teach middle school or junior high school, a license to teach secondary school and a special license. (NRS 391.031) The Commission on Professional Standards in Education is required to prescribe the qualifications and requirements for licensure. (NRS 391.019)

This bill establishes a new special license designated as a special qualifications license for an applicant with a master's degree or doctoral degree and work experience in the field for which the applicant will provide instruction. The new license must designate the grades and subject areas in which the person may teach. The Commission is required to adopt regulations providing for the issuance and renewal of the special qualifications license.
