Amend section 1, page 2, line 6, after “3.” by inserting:

“If any vehicle ceases to be exempt from taxation pursuant to this section because the owner is no longer on active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States, the owner shall notify the Department of that fact as soon as practicable after he becomes ineligible for the exemption. Upon receipt of the notice, the Department shall charge the governmental services tax to the owner in an amount that is prorated pursuant to subsection 6.

4. If the owner of a vehicle specified in subsection 3 fails to notify the Department pursuant to that subsection that he is no longer on active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States, the owner shall pay to the Department the governmental services tax for each year the owner fails to provide that notice, prorated pursuant to subsection 6 for the portion of the year in which the vehicle was exempt from the tax, together with the governmental services tax for the next

registration year and any fees for the renewal of the registration of the vehicle for that registration year.

Amend section 1, page 2, line 9, by deleting “4.” and inserting “6.”.

Amend section 1, page 2, between lines 12 and 13 by inserting:

“7. As used in this section, “active duty” means any period during which a person:

(a) Serves as a member of the Armed Forces of the United States or the National Guard or any reserve component thereof; and

(b) While serving in that capacity, is required to serve outside the State of Nevada in support of a worldwide contingency operation of the Armed Forces of the United States.”.

Amend the bill as a whole by deleting sec. 4 and renumbering sec. 5 as sec. 4.
