## Counsel's Digest will be changed to read as follows:

## **Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

Existing law requires the State Board of Health to regulate and license medical facilities and defines the types of medical facilities which must be licensed and regulated. (NRS 449.0151, 449.037)

This bill creates an additional type of medical facility, a community triage center, which must be regulated and licensed by the State Board of Health. A community triage center is defined as a facility that provides 24-hour medical assessment and short-term monitoring of mentally ill persons or abusers of alcohol or drugs. This bill requires the State Board of Health to adopt regulations, standards and licensing procedures for these centers.

This bill appropriates \$370,000 from the State General Fund to the Division of Mental Health and Developmental Services of the Department of Human Resources for establishing a mental health and substance abuse screening and stabilization component at a community triage center in Clark County. The provision pertaining to the appropriation becomes effective upon passage of this bill.
