For each regulation adopted pursuant to sections 2 to 12, inclusive, of this act, and submitted to the Legislative Counsel pursuant to NRS 233B.067 for review by the Legislative Commission, the Division shall set forth in the informational statement prepared pursuant to NRS 233B.066 that accompanies the regulation any supported living arrangement services that the regulation authorizes persons to provide pursuant to NRS 632.340 when the persons would otherwise be prohibited from providing such services pursuant to NRS 632.315.”.
