Amend sec. 3, page 3, by deleting lines 18 through 20 and inserting:

“5. ~~[Each]~~ *Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, each* member of a board of trustees of a district organized or reorganized pursuant to this chapter may receive as compensation for his service not more than \$6,000 per year . ~~[.]~~ *Each member of a board of trustees of a district that is organized or reorganized pursuant to this chapter and which is granted the powers set forth in NRS 318.140, 318.142 and 318.144 may receive as compensation for his service not more than \$9,000 per year. The compensation of the members of a board is payable*”.

Amend the title of the bill by deleting the third through fifth lines and inserting:

“relating to a district; revising the provisions governing the compensation of members of the board of trustees of districts; authorizing the board of trustees of”.
