Amend section 1, page 1, line 11, by deleting “*and*”.

Amend section 1, page 2, by deleting lines 1 through 3 and inserting:

*“(4) Provides transportation only to its customers, officers and directors; and**(5) Marks the vehicle with the owner’s or operator’s name or logo, which must be at least 2 inches in height and be visible from a distance of at least 50 feet; and”.*

Amend section 1, page 2, by deleting lines 7 through 16 and inserting:

“subsection 1 shall regularly inspect the motor vehicle and maintain a record of the inspection for at least 3 years after the date of the inspection. Each record maintained pursuant to this

subsection must be made available for inspection or audit by the Authority or its designee at any time during regular business hours.”.

Amend the title of the bill to read as follows:

“AN ACT relating to motor carriers; exempting an owner or operator of a motor vehicle that is used for the transportation of passengers or property from the provisions governing fully regulated carriers under certain circumstances; requiring the owner or operator to inspect the motor vehicle regularly and maintain a record of each inspection; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.”.
