Amend the bill as a whole by renumbering sections 6 and 7 as sections 7 and 8 and adding a new section designated sec. 6, following sec. 5, to read as follows:

“Sec. 6. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Commission on Ethics for the administrative costs to the Commission that are related to carrying out the provisions of section 1 of this act:

For the Fiscal Year 2005-2006\$10,900

For the Fiscal Year 2006-2007\$4,975
