*“a first responder”* and inserting *“another person”*.

Amend section 1, page 2, line 1, by deleting:

*“while performing his official duties”*.Amend section 1, page 2, line 4, after *“person”* by inserting:*“who committed the offense”*.

Amend section 1, page 2, by deleting line 16 and inserting:

*“compounded, another person suffers death”*.Amend section 1, page 2, line 17, by deleting *“official duties”*.

A.B. No. 531—Provides additional or alternative penalty if first responder suffers substantial bodily harm or death during discovery or cleanup of premises wherein certain controlled substances were unlawfully manufactured or compounded.

Amend section 1, pages 2 and 3, by deleting lines 34 through 44 on page 2 and lines 1 through 9 on page 3, and inserting:

***“4. As used in this section, “premises” means:”.***

Amend section 1, page 3, line 10, by deleting “(1)” and inserting “(a)”.

Amend section 1, page 3, line 14, by deleting “(2)” and inserting “(b)”.

Amend sec. 2, page 3, line 31, by deleting “***subsection 1***” and inserting “***subsection 2***”.

Amend the title of the bill, second line, by deleting “first responder” and inserting “person”.

Amend the summary of the bill to read as follows:

“SUMMARY—Provides additional or alternative penalty if person suffers substantial bodily harm or death during discovery or cleanup of premises wherein certain controlled substances were unlawfully manufactured or compounded. (BDR 40-105)”.
