Amend sec. 4, page 5, by deleting lines 36 through 39 and inserting:

“2. A licensed employee who is newly hired may not receive a signing bonus until he has worked for a school district in this State for at least 30 days. A licensed employee may not receive more than one signing bonus pursuant to this act. A licensed employee who is employed by a school district in this State”.

“SUMMARY—Requires Department of Education to transfer money from State Distributive School Account to provide signing bonuses to newly hired licensed employees of school districts. (BDR 34-477)”.
