A.B. No. 85—Revises provisions governing eligibility for millennium scholarship.

If this amendment is adopted, the Legislative

Counsel's Digest will be changed to read as follows:

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law establishes millennium scholarships and the eligibility requirements for receipt of such a scholarship. (NRS 396.911-396.938)

In addition to the other requirements for eligibility, this bill requires a student to perform at least 20 hours of community service which meets certain criteria established by the Board of Regents of the University of Nevada during the 4 years before he first becomes eligible for a millennium scholarship. This requirement will first apply to students who are eligible to receive a millennium scholarship on and after June 1, 2008.
