Amend the resolution, page 2, line 4, by deleting:

“Treasurer, [~~a Controller,~~]” and inserting:“~~[Treasurer, a Controller,~~ *Secretary of Finance*”.

Amend the resolution, page 2, between lines 13 and 14, by inserting:

“RESOLVED, That a new section, designated Section 19A, be added to Article 5 of the Nevada Constitution to read as follows:

Sec. 19A. The Secretary of Finance shall appoint as deputies a Treasurer and a Controller to assist in carrying out the duties of the Office of the Secretary of Finance. The Treasurer and Controller so appointed must be qualified to serve in such capacity as defined by the Legislature. And be it further”.

Amend the resolution, page 2, by deleting lines 16 and 17 and inserting:

A.J.R. No. 3—Proposes to amend Nevada Constitution to revise provisions governing certain constitutional officers.



“~~[Section]~~ **Sec. 22.** The Secretary of State, ~~[State Treasurer, State Controller,]~~ **Secretary of Finance**, Attorney General, and Superintendent of’.

Amend the resolution, page 2, by deleting lines 26 and 27 and inserting:

“shown by the reports of the county assessors to the ~~[State Controller,]~~ **Secretary of Finance**, except for the purpose of defraying”.

Amend the resolution, page 3, by deleting lines 15 and 16 and inserting:

“~~[Sec:]~~ **Sec. 12.** The Governor, Secretary of State, ~~[State Treasurer, State Controller,]~~ **Secretary of Finance** and Clerk of the Supreme”.

Amend the resolution, page 3, after line 18, by inserting:

“And be it further

RESOLVED, That this resolution becomes effective on January 3, 2011.”.

Amend the title of the resolution to read as follows:

“ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION—Proposing to amend the Nevada Constitution to eliminate the Office of State Controller and the Office of State Treasurer and to transfer those duties to the Office of the Secretary of Finance.”.

**If this amendment is adopted, the Legislative
Counsel's Digest will be changed to read as follows:**

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law establishes the position of State Controller as an elected state officer and prescribes the duties of the State Controller. (Nev. Const., Art. 5, § 19, Art. 9, § 3) Existing law establishes the position of State Treasurer as an elected state officer and prescribes the duties of the State Treasurer. (Nev. Const., Art. 5, § 19)

This resolution proposes to amend the Nevada Constitution to eliminate the positions of State Controller and State Treasurer and to transfer their respective duties to the Secretary of Finance. This resolution further proposes to amend the Nevada Constitution to require the Secretary of Finance to appoint as deputies a Controller and a Treasurer who are not constitutional officers but who assist the Secretary of Finance, and whose qualifications must be defined by the Legislature.
