Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law establishes term limits for State Legislators, the Governor and other state and local officers, and calls for the adoption of term limits for United States Senators and Representatives in Congress. (Nev. Const., Art. 4, §§ 3, 4; Art. 5, §§ 3, 19; Art. 15, § 3; Congressional Term Limits Act of 1996)

This resolution proposes to amend the State Constitution to remove these provisions.
