*“person who is a victim of identity theft.”.*

Amend section 1, page 2, line 22, after “8.” by inserting:

*“The Attorney General may accept gifts, grants and donations from any source for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this section.*

*9.”.*

Amend the title of the bill by deleting the fifth and sixth lines and inserting:

“requiring the Attorney General to adopt regulations relating to the issuance of identify theft passports; authorizing the Attorney General to accept gifts, grants and donations to carry out the provisions relating to the issuance of identity theft passports; and”.
