S.B. No. 31—Revises provisions relating to Nevada Silver Haired Legislative Forum.



If this amendment is adopted, the Legislative

Counsel's Digest will be changed to read as follows:

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Under existing law, a member must be removed from the Nevada Silver Haired Legislative Forum if he is absent from three consecutive meetings. (NRS 427A.360)

This bill authorizes the President of the Forum, in his discretion, to excuse absences from meetings.

Existing law provides that officers of the Nevada Silver Haired Legislative Forum serve a term of 1 year beginning at the first meeting every year of the Forum. (NRS 427A.370)

The bill provides that officers of the Forum serve a term of 1 year beginning on July 1 of each year.

Existing law authorizes the Nevada Silver Haired Legislative Forum to hold public hearings but places restrictions on the number and location of the hearings. (NRS 427A.380)

This bill authorizes the Forum to hold three or more public hearings in the State when the Legislature is not in a regular session and removes the requirement that the meetings, if held, be held in different areas of the State.

Existing law authorizes the Nevada Silver Haired Legislative Forum to submit recommendations for legislation to the Legislative Commission and the Governor before July 1 of each even-numbered year. (NRS 427A.390)

The bill provides that the Forum may submit recommendations for legislation to the Legislative Commission and the Governor before September 1 of each even-numbered year.
