THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
- 2 General Fund to the Department of Education the sum of \$116,316
- 3 for unanticipated expenses for Fiscal Year 2004-2005 relating to the
- 4 Individuals with Disabilities Education Act. This appropriation is
- 5 supplemental to that made by section 15 of chapter 327, Statutes of
- 6 Nevada 2003, at page 1831.
- 7 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
