AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Department of Education for unanticipated expenses for Fiscal Year 2004-2005 relating to the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State  
2 General Fund to the Department of Education the sum of \$87,590  
3 for unanticipated expenses for Fiscal Year 2004-2005 relating to the  
4 Individuals with Disabilities Education Act. This appropriation is  
5 supplemental to that made by section 15 of chapter 327, Statutes of  
6 Nevada 2003, at page 1831.

7       **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
