AN ACT relating to public health; requiring hospitals to provide patients with certain information regarding the Bureau for Hospital Patients; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

- 1 Existing law requires each medical facility, facility for the dependent and  
2 home for individual residential care to inform each patient or his legal  
3 representative, upon admission to the facility or home, of certain rights of the  
4 patient. (NRS 449.730)  
5 This bill requires each hospital, upon the admission of a patient, to provide to  
6 the patient or his legal representative certain written information explaining the  
7 existence of the Bureau for Hospital Patients within the Office for Consumer  
8 Health Assistance in the Office of the Governor, the services provided by the  
9 Bureau and the manner in which the Bureau may be contacted.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** NRS 449.730 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2         449.730   1. Every medical facility, facility for the dependent  
3 and home for individual residential care shall inform each patient or  
4 his legal representative, upon his admission to the facility or home,  
5 of the patient's rights as listed in NRS 449.700, 449.710, 449.715  
6 and 449.720.

1       2. In addition to the requirements of subsection 1, if a person  
2 with a disability is a patient at a facility, as that term is defined in  
3 NRS 449.771, the facility shall inform the patient of his rights  
4 pursuant to NRS 449.765 to 449.786, inclusive.

5       ***3. In addition to the requirements of subsections 1 and 2,  
6 every hospital shall, upon the admission of a patient to the  
7 hospital, provide to the patient or his legal representative a written  
8 disclosure approved by the Director, which written disclosure must  
9 set forth:***

10      ***(a) Notice of the existence of the Bureau for Hospital Patients  
11 created pursuant to NRS 223.575;***

12      ***(b) The address and telephone number of the Bureau; and***

13      ***(c) An explanation of the services provided by the Bureau,  
14 including, without limitation, the services for dispute resolution  
15 described in subsection 3 of NRS 223.575.***

16      **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2005.
