
SENATE BILL NO. 193—COMMITTEE ON
HUMAN RESOURCES AND EDUCATION

MARCH 17, 2005

Referred to Committee on Human Resources and Education

SUMMARY—Makes various changes concerning Committee on Anatomical Dissection established by University and Community College System of Nevada and distribution and treatment of dead bodies. (BDR 40-51)

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EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to public health; making various changes concerning the Committee on Anatomical Dissection established by the University and Community College System of Nevada; prohibiting a person from receiving a dead body under certain circumstances; decreasing the period of time that the Committee is required to retain any dead body it receives in a receiving vault to not less than 30 days; requiring the Committee to charge and collect certain fees for obtaining, handling and distributing dead bodies; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law authorizes the University and Community College System of
2 Nevada to establish a Committee on Anatomical Dissection. (NRS 451.360) The
3 Committee receives certain dead human bodies and distributes such bodies to
4 certain schools, teaching hospitals and other groups which the Committee
5 determines are eligible to receive such bodies for the promotion of medical science.
6 (NRS 451.400, 451.410 and 451.450) The Committee is required to submit a report
7 of its activities to the Presidents of the University and Community College System
8 of Nevada and the State Board of Health. (NRS 451.370) The Committee is also
9 required to retain each dead body it receives in a receiving vault for not less than 60
10 days before allowing its use for medical science. (NRS 451.410)



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11 This bill revises certain provisions relating to the membership of the Committee
12 and requires that the member appointed by the President of the University of Nevada,
13 Reno, or the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, be elected as Chairman.
14 The Chairman and Secretary hold office for 1 year and the Committee is required to
15 meet at least twice annually.

16 This bill also establishes certain duties for the Committee. The Committee is
17 required to prepare and approve an annual budget and to submit the report of its
18 activities to the Governor and the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for
19 transmittal to the appropriate committees of the Legislature. This bill further
20 requires the Committee to adopt regulations concerning the persons and entities that
21 are eligible to receive dead human bodies. The Committee is also required to retain
22 each dead body it receives in a receiving vault for not less than 30 days before
23 allowing its use for medical science.

24 This bill requires the Committee to charge and collect certain fees from a
25 university, state college, community college or medical school within the
26 University and Community College System of Nevada and any other person or
27 entity which receives dead bodies from the Committee for medical science.

28 This bill prohibits a person and entity from receiving a dead body for the
29 promotion of medical science unless the Committee determines that the person is
30 eligible to receive such body. A person or entity that receives a dead body without
31 the Committee making such a determination is guilty of a gross misdemeanor.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 451.360 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 451.360 **1.** The University and Community College System
3 of Nevada may establish a Committee on Anatomical Dissection
4 ~~[which must be composed as follows:~~

5 **1. One doctor of medicine] consisting of:**
6 **(a) One member who is a physician licensed to practice**
7 ***medicine pursuant to the provisions of chapter 630 of NRS,***
8 appointed by the Nevada State Medical Association.

9 **2. One doctor of]**
10 ***(b) One member who is an osteopathic physician licensed to***
11 ***practice osteopathic medicine pursuant to the provisions of***
12 ***chapter 633 of NRS, appointed by the Nevada Osteopathic Medical***
13 ***Association.***

14 **(c) One member who is a dentist licensed to practice** dentistry
15 ***pursuant to the provisions of chapter 631 of NRS,*** appointed by the
16 Nevada ~~[State]~~ Dental Association.

17 **3. (d) One member who is a pathologist ,** appointed by the
18 Nevada ~~[State]~~ Society of Pathologists.

19 **4. (e) One member appointed by the President of the** University of
20 ***Nevada, Reno ,*** from the faculty of the University of
21 Nevada, Reno.



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1 [5.] (f) One member appointed by the President of the
2 University of Nevada, Las Vegas , from the faculty of the University
3 of Nevada, Las Vegas.

4 [6.] (g) *One member appointed by the President of the Touro*
5 *University College of Osteopathic Medicine, Nevada, or its*
6 *successor, from the faculty of the Touro University College of*
7 *Osteopathic Medicine, Nevada.*

8 (h) The State Health Officer , or ~~One of his staff appointed by~~
9 ~~him,~~

10 —7.] *his designee.*

11 (i) One member appointed by the Nevada Funeral Service
12 Association.

13 **2. The Committee shall elect:**

14 (a) *The member appointed by the President of the University of*
15 *Nevada, Reno, or the member appointed by the President of the*
16 *University of Nevada, Las Vegas, to serve as Chairman of the*
17 *Committee; and*

18 (b) *A Secretary from among its members.*

19 3. *The Chairman and Secretary shall hold office for a term of*
20 *1 year.*

21 Sec. 2. NRS 451.370 is hereby amended to read as follows:

22 451.370 **1. The Committee shall meet:**

23 (a) *At least twice annually and at other times specified by a*
24 *call of the Chairman of the Committee or a majority of its*
25 *members; and*

26 (b) *At places specified by the Chairman.*

27 2. The Committee shall keep full and complete minutes of each
28 meeting of the Committee and a complete record of all dead human
29 bodies received and distributed by it and of the persons to whom the
30 bodies may be distributed. The minutes and records must be open at
31 all times ~~to the inspection of~~ for inspection by each member of the
32 Committee and ~~of~~ by the district attorney of any county within the
33 State.

34 3. *The Secretary of the Committee is responsible for keeping*
35 *the minutes of each meeting of the Committee and preparing and*
36 *maintaining a complete file of the minutes and records of the*
37 *Committee.*

38 4. *The Committee shall prepare and approve an annual*
39 *budget for the Committee.*

40 5. A report of the activities of the Committee must be made
41 before September 1 of each even-numbered year covering the
42 biennium ending June 30 of such year to ~~the~~:

43 (a) *The Presidents of the University and Community College*
44 *System of Nevada* ~~and to the~~;



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1 (b) *The State Board of Health [One of the members of the
2 Committee from the University and Community College System of
3 Nevada must act as Secretary and shall be responsible for preparing
4 and maintaining a complete file of such minutes and records.]*;

5 (c) *The Governor; and*

6 (d) *The Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for
7 transmittal to the appropriate committee or committees of the
8 Legislature.*

9 Sec. 3. NRS 451.390 is hereby amended to read as follows:

10 451.390 The Committee shall ~~from time to time~~ adopt such
11 regulations as it may deem necessary for the performance of its
12 duties ~~[The Committee may meet regularly once a year and at such
13 other times as it deems necessary]~~, including, without limitation,
14 regulations concerning the persons and entities that are eligible to
15 receive dead bodies pursuant to NRS 451.450.

16 Sec. 4. NRS 451.400 is hereby amended to read as follows:

17 451.400 1. All public officers, agents or employees of every
18 county, city or town, every person in charge of any prison, morgue,
19 hospital, funeral parlor or mortuary, and all other persons coming
20 into possession, charge or control of any dead human body which is
21 unclaimed or which is required to be buried at public expense are
22 hereby required to notify *immediately* the Committee ~~immediately,
23 or such person as may from time to time be designated by the
24 Committee, or its designee.~~

25 2. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 451.420, every ~~such~~
26 person *required to notify the Committee or its designee of his
27 possession, charge or control of a dead human body pursuant to
28 subsection 1* shall, upon the request of the Committee and without
29 fee, deliver such a dead body to the Committee, or to such agent,
30 institution or person as the Committee ~~shall~~ *may* designate.

31 Sec. 5. NRS 451.410 is hereby amended to read as follows:

32 451.410 ~~All bodies~~ *Each dead human body* received by the
33 Committee shall be retained in *a* receiving ~~vaults~~ *vault* for a period
34 of not less than ~~60~~ *30* days before allowing ~~their~~ *its* use for
35 medical science. If at any time more bodies are made available to
36 the Committee than can be used for medical science under its
37 jurisdiction, or a body shall be deemed by the Committee to be unfit
38 for anatomical purposes, the Committee may notify, in writing, the
39 *board of* county commissioners of the county where the death
40 occurred. Upon receiving such notification, the *board of* county
41 commissioners shall direct ~~some~~ *a* person to take charge of such
42 body and cause it to be buried *or cremated* in accordance with the
43 existing rules, laws and practices for disposing of unclaimed bodies
44 within such county.



1 **Sec. 6.** NRS 451.450 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 451.450 **1.** The Committee or its duly authorized agent shall
3 take and receive the bodies delivered to it **[under] pursuant to** the
4 provisions of NRS 451.350 to 451.470, inclusive, and shall
5 distribute such bodies proportionately and equitably, among
6 schools, teaching hospitals **[wherein the] in which there is a**
7 resident training program **that** requires cadaveric material for study,
8 and such other **[group]** person or entity as the Committee may
9 determine to be eligible to receive such bodies.

10 **2. The Committee shall charge and collect:**

11 (a) *From a university, state college, community college or
12 medical school within the University and Community College
13 System of Nevada and any other medical school in this State to
14 which the Committee distributes a dead human body in
15 accordance with subsection 1, a fee in an amount not to exceed
16 the expenses of the Committee to obtain, handle and distribute the
17 body delivered to it pursuant to the provisions of NRS 451.350 to
18 451.470, inclusive; and*

19 (b) *From any other person or entity to which the Committee
20 distributes a dead human body in accordance with subsection 1:*

21 (1) *A fee in an amount not to exceed the expenses of the
22 Committee to obtain, handle and distribute the body delivered to it
23 pursuant to the provisions of NRS 451.350 to 451.470, inclusive;
24 and*

25 (2) *An additional fee of \$200 for each body distributed to
26 the person or entity which must be used by the Committee to carry
27 out the provisions of NRS 451.350 to 451.470, inclusive.*

28 **3. A person or entity may not receive a dead body for the
29 promotion of medical science unless the Committee has
30 determined that the person or entity is eligible to receive the dead
31 body. A person or entity who receives a dead body in violation of
32 this subsection is guilty of a gross misdemeanor.**

33 **Sec. 7.** NRS 451.460 is hereby amended to read as follows:

34 451.460 **[No] The Committee shall not distribute a body
35 delivered to it pursuant to the provisions of NRS 451.350 to
36 451.470, inclusive, to a university, school, college, teaching hospital
37 or [association shall be allowed or permitted to receive any such
38 body] entity pursuant to NRS 451.450 until the university, school,
39 college, teaching hospital or entity submits a bond, [approved as to]
40 in a form approved by the Attorney General, [has been given] to the
41 Committee. Such bond shall be in the penal sum of \$1,000
42 conditioned that all such bodies received by such university, school,
43 college, teaching hospital or association shall be used for no other
44 purpose than the promotion of medical science within this State.**



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1 **Sec. 8.** NRS 451.470 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 451.470 At any time any body, or part of any body accepted by
3 the Committee, has been used and deemed of no further value to
4 medical or dental science, the person having charge of such body or
5 parts of such body ~~will~~ **shall** dispose of the remains by cremation
6 or as otherwise specified under prior mutually agreed special
7 conditions of acceptance.
