AN ACT relating to persons with disabilities; authorizing certain persons with physical disabilities to use signature stamps under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1        This bill authorizes the use of signature stamps by persons with physical  
2        disabilities who are unable to write because of their disabilities and creates an  
3        exception to any law that requires a handwritten signature. In situations in which a  
4        signature must be witnessed or has other qualifying requirements, the person with a  
5        disability is required to use the stamp in the presence of a witness and meet any  
6        other qualifying requirements.

7        This bill also requires the Office of Disability Services in the Department of  
8        Human Resources to adopt standards regarding the use of signature stamps and  
9        requires the Department of Human Resources to adopt regulations regarding the use  
10      of signature stamps.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** Chapter 426 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3      ***1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2 and  
4 notwithstanding any other provision of law:***

5      ***(a) A person with a physical disability who, by reason of the  
6 physical disability, is unable to write may use a signature stamp to  
7 affix his signature to a document or writing any time that a  
8 signature is required by law; and***

9      ***(b) A person, government, governmental agency and political  
10 subdivision of a government must treat each signature affixed by a  
11 person described in paragraph (a) through the use of a signature  
12 stamp in the same manner as it treats a signature made in writing.***

13     ***2. The provisions of subsection 1 do not apply to a document  
14 or writing with respect to which the requirement that the  
15 document or writing must be signed is accompanied by an  
16 additional qualifying requirement unless each additional  
17 qualifying requirement is satisfied.***

18     ***3. The Office shall develop standards regarding signature  
19 stamps for persons with physical disabilities who, by reason of  
20 their physical disabilities, are unable to write, including, without  
21 limitation, standards pertaining to:***

22      ***(a) The development of a signature stamp;***

23      ***(b) The use of a signature stamp;***

24      ***(c) The verification of a signature stamp; and***

25      ***(d) Any other aspect of the use or verification of signature  
26 stamps that the Office determines to be necessary.***

27     ***4. The Department shall adopt regulations to carry out the  
28 standards developed by the Office pursuant to subsection 3 and  
29 any other regulations to carry out the provisions of this section.***

30     ***5. As used in this section, "signature stamp" means a stamp  
31 which contains the impression of:***

32      ***(a) The actual signature of a person with a physical disability;***

33      ***(b) A mark or symbol which is adopted by the person with the  
34 physical disability; or***

35      ***(c) A signature of the name of a person with a physical  
36 disability which is made by another person and which is adopted  
37 by the person with the physical disability.***

38     ***Sec. 2.* NRS 426.205 is hereby amended to read as follows:**

39     ***426.205 As used in NRS 426.205 to 426.295, inclusive, **and**  
40 **section 1 of this act,** unless the context otherwise requires, the  
41 words and terms defined in NRS 426.215 and 426.225 have the  
42 meanings ascribed to them in those sections.***
