SUMMARY—Makes appropriation to Andre Agassi College Preparatory Academy for construction of facility to provide full-day kindergarten and first grade. (BDR S-1284)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Andre Agassi College Preparatory Academy for the construction of a facility to provide full-day kindergarten and first grade; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

1 WHEREAS, The Andre Agassi College Preparatory Academy is a
2 public charter school established in 2001 through the vision of
3 Andre Agassi; and

4 WHEREAS, The Andre Agassi College Preparatory Academy has
5 received in excess of \$15 million for the construction of the
6 buildings on its campus; and

7 WHEREAS, The vast majority of that money was provided by
8 private donations to The Andre Agassi Charitable Foundation and
9 The Charter School Development Foundation; and

10 WHEREAS, The Andre Agassi College Preparatory Academy
11 currently offers grades 3 through 8; and

12 WHEREAS, The Andre Agassi College Preparatory Academy
13 will be adding full-day kindergarten and first grade in August 2005;
14 now, therefore,



1 THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
2 SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

4 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
5 General Fund to the Andre Agassi College Preparatory Academy the
6 sum of \$900,000 for the construction of a facility to provide full-day
7 kindergarten and first grade.

8 **Sec. 2.** The appropriation made by section 1 of this act is
9 contingent upon the Andre Agassi College Preparatory Academy
10 obtaining materials for the facility through partnerships with private
11 organizations.

12 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
